#### Section C-

#### SIGNALLING AND PERMANENT WAY ALTERATIONS

#### GREETLAND No. 2, ELLAND AND BRIGHOUSE STATION.

#### SATURDAY to WEDNESDAY, 17th to 21st MAY.

From 10-0 pm (Saturday) to 5-0 pm (Wednesday) alterations will be made to the permanent way and signalling between Greetland No. 2 and Brighouse Station Signal Boxes. Elland East, Elland West and Waterhouse Siding Signal Boxes will be closed and a new Signal Box (at Elland) brought into use.

In the event of a Driver receiving instructions from a handsignalman which conflict with an aspect displayed by a signal he must work to the handsignalman's instructions. Between 5-0 pm (Monday) and 5-0 pm (Wednesday) the new equipment will be tested as necessary.

#### SIGNALLING ARRANGEMENTS.

#### Main Running Signals.

The colour light signals to be introduced will conform with provisions of Rule 35 and will give indications as shown on the accompanying drawing. The small offset green aspects provided at D.33 Down Main Automatic and Brighouse No. 6 Down Main Outer Home signals will act as directing distants for trains proceeding to the Down Slow line at Brighouse Station.

A new Signal Box, situated on the Up side at the East end of Elland Station, will be brought into use, and will operate the remaining points and signals previously worked from Elland East and Elland West Signal Boxes together with the following:

No. 6 C.E.A. Sidings to Down Main (power worked), previously worked from Ground Frame.

No. 3 Up Main Home No. 1. Up Main to C.E.A. Sidings. 3-aspect colour light showing R, Y or G. Right-hand Offset Small Yellow. Situated on Up Side of Up Main 1,919 yards East of Signal Box.

No. 24 Up Goods to Up Loop Home

Left-hand Offset Small Yellow.

No. 35 Up Main Home No. 2.

3-aspect colour light showing R, Y or G. Erected on Up side of Up Main, 699 yards East of Signal Box.

No. 7 C.E.A. Sidings to Down Main.

3-aspect colour light, showing R, Y or G, erected on Down side of C.E.A. Sidings 1,557 yards East of Signal Box.

No. 8 Down Main Starting.

3-aspect colour light, showing R, Y or G, erected between C.E.A. Sidings and Down Main 1,137 yards East of Signal Box.
