Commencing at 08.00 hours on Saturday 18 October until 08.00 hours on Tuesday 28 October or until the work is completed alterations to permanent way and signalling will be carried out as indicated below :

1. Alterations to Permanent Way

The new crossovers (in heavy type on the attached diagram) between the Up Relief and Down Main (719 points) and between the Up Main and Down Main (745 points) will be brought into use.

The existing crossover (746 points) between the Up Relief and Down Main will be relayed approximately 40 yds to the East Usk side of its present position.

All these connections will be operated by clamp locks. The connections shown dotted on the enclosed diagram will be recovered and 747B double slip will be temporarily arranged to operate as a simple switch.

2. Alterations to Signalling (see attached diagram)

- Up Relief - N329

A position 1 route indicator will be brought into use for the new route from the Up Relief to the Up Main.

- Up Main - N124

All routes from this signal will be recovered except those to

- (a) No.2 line - Main and Draw Ahead.
(Revised route indication "2")
- (b) No.1 line - Main and Draw Ahead.
(Revised route indication "1")
- (c) E6 signal - Shunt only.

Up Hereford Goods - M8

The route to N124 signal will be reinstated. A new route to N224 signal will be introduced.

3. A.W.S.

An A.W.S. inductor will be provided in the Up Main to Down Main crossover between N129 and N224 signals.

4. Track Circuits

The track circuiting in the area will be re-arranged as necessary.
