N.B. The Up Reception/Up Goods Line will be set for through working between connections at Llanelli East, Llandeilo Jn West and Llandeilo Jn East.

DOWN SIDE

Down sidings Nos. 3, 6, 7, and 8 - 12 inclusive.

Down siding No. 7 (Goods) will remain in use.

Down sidings 4 and 5 will be converted to "dead end" sidings with temporary stop blocks provided at the Llandeilo Jn East End and served from the West end.

A board worded "DRIVERS OF LOCOMOTIVES MUST STOP FOR INSTRUCTIONS" will be positioned for the Through Siding on the Up Side alongside the Train Crew Supervisor's Office facing Up Direction trains.
