Scunthorpe B.S.C. Coal Terminal

On and from Sunday 22 February new rapid discharge facilities will be brought into use at B.S.C. Scunthorpe. The facilities will consist of a rapid discharge bunker flanked by gross and tare weighbridges served by 2 arrival lines 'A' and 'B' together with Empties, Run Round and Departure lines. A Cripple siding will also be installed. Bunker unloading signals operated by the Bunker operator will control movements through the Bunker.

The present Grimsby Siding will be re-named Up Scunthorpe Goods Loop and a new facing connection from this loop leading to 'A' or 'B' Arrival lines will be brought into use together with a new trailing connection from the Departure Line into Up Scunthorpe. A new facing connection Up Scunthorpe to Up Scunthorpe Goods Loop will be brought into use immediately after passing S.344 signal.

Signalling

A new signal will be installed at the exit from the Bunker departure Line - S.347.
