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The new depot at Crown Point will be commisioned at 14 00 hours Sunday 3 October and details of the internal layout, signalling etc., are as shown on the attached diagram.

All remaining facilities will be brought into use with power-worked points signals and 'RIGHT – AWAY' Indicators being controlled from CROWN POINT DEPOT CONTROL CABIN.

When the 'RIGHT-AWAY' Indicator at the exit from a particular Siding is illuminated, the movement may proceed towards ground position light 1481.

The following signalling alterations have already been published but are repeated here in the interest of completeness.

Wensum Junction

The signal box, together with all semaphore signalling controlled therefrom has been abolished. The **Block section is now between Norwich Thorpe Junction and Whitlingham Junction**. Remodelling has taken place in the Wensum Junction area and all points and ground position light signals including the trailing crossover between the Down and Up Lowestoft lines (previously controlled by Wensum Junction) are controlled from the new **Crown Point Depot Control Cabin**.

The former Through siding has been renamed No.2 Reception.

The former Up Goods has been reinstated as No.1 Reception line.

Alterations to Existing Signalling NJ = Norwich Thorpe Junction

A 6-way route indicator has been provided on Up Lowestoft 4-aspect signal NJ500 and the following indications apply — all subsidiary routes are controlled from the new Crown Point Depot Control Cabin (CP).
