DRIVERS TO KEEP A GOOD LOOK-OUT FOR HANDSIGNALS

Chislehurst Junction signal box will be abolished and the area previously controlled by this signal box will be transferred to the new Ashford signalling centre (AD). All signals within the area designated as new signalling will be prefixed 'AD' and telephones will communicate with Ashford signalling centre (AD).

The Chislehurst North and South tunnels will be renamed Chislehurst Slow and Chislehurst Fast.

The following new lines will be brought into use:

Up Slow Tonbridge Loop

Down Fast Tonbridge Loop

Full details are shown on the enclosed diagram.
