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#### AIRDRIE SIGNAL BOX.

#### SATURDAY, SUNDAY and MONDAY, 30th, 31st JULY and 1st AUGUST.

Commencing at 2.30 p.m. on Saturday, 30th July, all main line signals at Airdrie will be disconnected and drivers hand-signalled as necessary until completion of the work about 5.0 a.m. on Monday, 1st August.

On completion of the work, the new and altered signalling shown on the accompanying diagram and described below, will be brought into use.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SCHEME.**

All main line running signals will be of the colour light type, subsidiary signals of the position light type, and all ground signals will be of the floodlit disc type.

#### PERMANENT WAY ALTERATIONS.

Trap points will be provided in the Bay platform line immediately ahead of signal AD.47.

Four carriage sidings will be provided on the Down side adjacent to the Bay platform with a connection to the Bay platform line 47 yards after passing signal AD.47. Trap points will be provided at the exit of Nos. 1 and 2 and 3 and 4 sidings.

Facing points leading to a sand drag will be provided in the Down line 435 yards after passing signal AD.48. Up line catch points will be repositioned 250 yards after passing signal AD.43.
