## SUNDAY 13th JULY 1969

Rules, 77, 78, 79 and 80 to be observed. Drivers to keep a good look-out for hand signals

Commencing at 00 10 on **Sunday 13th July,** colour light signalling with Track Circuit Block Working, together with Permanent Way alterations, will be introduced within the area above.

Certain lines will be renamed. Full details of the new signalling are shown on the diagram accompanying this notice.

Controlled signals will be fitted with a plate bearing prefix letters and numbers, the letters indicating the signal box from which they are controlled as follows:—

Automatic signals will be prefixed by the letters "CA".

## SIGNALLING RECORD SOCIETY

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Lamps which flash with a white light, will be fixed to certain apparatus cases in the area to call the attention of the Technician.

Telephones will be provided at, or adjacent to, signals and certain points, the prefix letters indicating the signal box to which they communicate.

Attention is drawn to JC.150 and CA.235 signals in Crystal Palace Tunnel where the red aspect will be uppermost and will be  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet above rail level.

The Junction indicator associated with JC.150 signal is offset against the red (top) aspect and is of reduced size.
