Instructions to all concerned as to

ALTERATIONS TO COLOUR LIGHT SIGNALLING

BETWEEN WEST BYFLEET AND WOKING

ON

SUNDAY, 30th NOVEMBER 1969

Rules 77, 78, 79 and 80 to be observed. Drivers to keep a good look-out for hand signals.

Commencing at 00 15 on Sunday, 30th November the colour light signalling between the above locations will be altered.

Controlled signals will be fitted with plates bearing prefix letters and numbers, the letters indicating the signal box from which they are controlled as follows:—

Signal Box F
West Byfleet

WU

Woking

W۷

Automatic signals will be prefixed "WA".

Telephones will be provided at or adjacent to the new signals and will communicate with the signal box.

Attention is drawn to signals WA.491 and WA.493 which, until further notice, will act as 2-aspect signals (red or green) with the yellow aspects obliterated. Signals WA.495 and WA.497 will, until further notice, act as 3-aspect signals with the top yellow aspects obliterated.

Full details are shown on the diagram enclosed with this notice.

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
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
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
