DRIVERS TO KEEP A GOOD LOOK-OUT FOR HAND SIGNALS

Star Bridge, Merstham and Holmthorpe signalboxes will be abolished.

New signalling will be introduced, controlled from Redhill 'A' (RH) as shown on the enclosed diagram.

The Down Main signal RH479 will display a double yellow aspect when Redhill 'A' (RH) Down Through Home signal is in the 'OFF' position. To display a green aspect, requires Redhill 'B' Down Main Distant signal to be in the 'OFF' position.

All signal post telephones will communicate with Redhill 'A' (RH) signalbox unless otherwise shown.

Track Circuit Block working will be introduced on the Down and Up Main lines between Coulsdon North and Redhill 'A' (RH).


