ALTERATIONS TO SIGNALLING AND PERMANENT WAY BETWEEN MAIDSTONE EAST AND HOTHFIELD ON SATURDAYS 14 AND 28 APRIL 1984

DRIVERS TO KEEP A GOOD LOOK-OUT FOR HAND SIGNALS

Bearsted, Hollingbourne, Lenham, Charing and Hothfield signal boxes will be abolished; control of points and signals will be transferred to Maidstone East signal box (prefix 'ME') as shown on the enclosed diagram.

The work will be carried out in stages thus:

SATURDAY 14 APRIL - STAGE 4A

Abolition of Bearsted and Hollingbourne signal boxes and introduction of Track Circuit Block working on the Down and Up lines between Maidstone East and Lenham.

In addition, Charing signal box and all signals worked therefrom will be abolished.

SATURDAY 28 APRIL - STAGE 4B

Abolition of Lenham and Hothfield signal boxes and introduction of Track Circuit Block working on the Down and Up lines between Lenham and Hothfield (Ashford).
