DRIVERS TO KEEP A GOOD LOOK-OUT FOR HAND SIGNALS

New signalling and permanent way will be introduced, as shown on the diagram overleaf.

Reversible signalling will be introduced on the single line between Point Pleasant Junction and East Putney. East Putney, Wimbledon Park and Wimbledon "A" signal boxes will be abolished, and control of points and signals will be from Wimbledon (W) signal box.

A telephone, giving communication with Wimbledon (W) signal box, will be provided at each stop signal.

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
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
