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BETWEEN WILLESDEN AND WEMBLEY: SIGNALLING AND PERMANENT WAY ALTERATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE NEW WEMBLEY EUROPEAN FREIGHT OPERATING CENTRE

General The new Wembley European Freight Operating Centre is situated on the Up side of the West Coast Main line between 7 and 8 mp with connections to the Low Level Goods lines/High Level Arrival and Departure lines at the South end and the Down/Up Slow lines at the North end. A connection to/from the Centre is also provided at the Northern End of the Down Through Siding Nos. 1 and 2, Nos. 1 and 2 Goods Departure lines and the Up Goods Reception line.

Permanent Way Alterations

New connections will be provided in the Down and Up Low Level Goods lines in the area of the 1½ mile post (Low Level Goods mileage) leading to/from new South Arrival and Departure lines and to new Sidings to be known as "B" and "C" Sidings.

New connections will be provided between the Down and Up Goods lines and the South Arrival/Departure lines and Locomotive Sidings at the Northern end of Down Through Sidings 1 and 2/Nos. 1 and 2 Goods Departure/Up Goods Reception lines.

New connections will be provided in the Down and Up Slow lines immediately south of Wembley Station leading to/from the new North Arrival and Departure lines.

Within the new Centre seven new Reception/Departure lines will be provided each approximately 800 yards in length with three locomotive sidings at the South end and two locomotive sidings and a Shunting Neck at the North end. At the North end of the Centre a Yard line will be provided adjacent to the Reception/Departure lines leading to/from five through sidings to be known as "A" Sidings, seven dead end sidings and one through siding to be known as "B" Sidings and five through sidings to be known as "C" Sidings. Two Crippled Wagon Sidings will be provided at the South end of "C" Sidings and a Customs Examination Siding connected to the South Departure line.

Access to/from the North end of the InterCity Carriage Servicing Depot will be via the new North Arrival line.

New and Altered Signalling

The connections to and from the new Centre together with those to and from the Locomotive Sidings and Shunt Neck at the North end will be controlled by new or altered signalling from Willesden signal box (prefix WN). The connections within the new Centre will be controlled by a new signal box to be known as Wembley Yard (prefix WY). All points within the Centre will be power worked with the exception of those within "B" and "C" Sidings and at the North end of "A" Sidings.

All lines within the new Centre will be signalled for bi-directional working.

The lines to and from and including Nos. 1-7 Reception and Departure lines will be signalled as Running lines as will the Yard line in the Up direction and the line from Down Low Level Goods or Down High Level towards signal WY190.

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A diagram showing the new layout and signalling is included in this notice as are details of the additional routes on signals controlled by Willesden signal box and all signals controlled by the new Wembley Yard signal box.

Telephones

Telephones communicating with the relevant signal box will be provided at all running signals. Other telephones are shown on the diagram.

Speed Restrictions


