The existing Bullo Pill East Down Main Distant which is at present a lower arm beneath the Newnham Down Main Advanced Starting will be recovered. The A.T.C. ramp for this signal will be refixed 440 yards in the rear of the new Bullo Pill East Down Main Distant.

The existing Up Main and Down A.T.C. Ramps for Newnham will be refixed 200 yards in rear of the Up Main Colour Light Intermediate Block Section Distant for Bullo Pill East and the Down Main Colour Light Intermediate Block Section Distant for Grange Court, respectively.

A new ground frame, to be known as Newnham Ground Frame, situated 1628 yards from and controlled by Control Instruments in Bullo Pill East Signal Box, will be brought into use to work the existing trailing connection from Down Main to Down Sidings.

The Control Instrument will release a key release instrument, the key (Pattern A) of which will release the Ground Frame.

When the Ground Frame is in use the Down Main Block Instrument between Grange Court and Bullo Pill East will be maintained in the "Train on Line" position.

The existing Block Telegraph sections Grange Court—Newnham—Bullo Pill East will be re-arranged to become Grange Court—Bullo Pill East.

The following signals will be released by line clear (one train only). Bullo Pill East Up Main Colour Light I.B.S. Home. Grange Court Down Main Colour Light I.B.S. Home.

The following signals will be released by line clear (one pull only).

Bullo Pill East Down Main Home.
Bullo Pill East Up Main to Down Main Disc.
Bullo Pill East Up Siding to Down Main Disc.

The existing Block switch at Grange Court Signal Box will be recovered.

Telephones on independent circuits to Bullo Pill East Signal Box will be provided at the Up Main Colour Light Intermediate Block Section Home for Bullo Pill East, and Newnham Ground Frame, respectively, for the use of enginemen.

A Telephone on an independent circuit to Grange Court signal box will be provided at the Down Main Colour Light Intermediate Block Section Home for Grange Court, for the use of enginemen.

Up and Down Colour Light Intermediate Block Home Signals worked in accordance with the instructions under the heading "Intermediate Block Signals" in the General Appendix to the Rule Book and in the Regulations for Train Signalling on the Double and Single Lines are provided in the vicinity of Newnham approximately midway between Bullo Pill East and Grange Court Signal Boxes.

The Up Main Intermediate Signals are operated from Bullo Pill East Signal Box and Down Main Intermediate Signals from Grange Court Signal Box.

Down Sidings

The trailing connection Down Main to Down Siding is worked by a one lever ground frame operated by Key Control Instrument at Bullo Pill East Signal Box and Key Release Instrument at the ground frame. For method of working see standard instructions in the General Appendix.
