Between 07.00 hours and 17.00 hours on Sunday, 3rd November, or until completion the Divisional Civil Engineer and Chief Signal & Telecommunications Engineer will be engaged in carrying out the work detailed below and shown on the attached diagram:

The following new Ground discs will be brought into use as shown on the attached diagram.

- A Down Main to No. 2 Up Siding or No. 1 Up Siding or Up Goods
- B Loop Staing to No. 2 Up Staing or its at up stains of Up Goods
- E Down Goods to Loop Siding or Down Main.
- F Backing from Up Sidings to Down Goods.
- G No. 2 Up Siding to Through Siding.
- H No. 1 Up Siding to Through Siding.
- K Through Siding to Down Goods or No. 1 Up Siding or No. 2 Up Siding.

A new Stop Lamp L will be provided as shown on attached diagram.

A new illuminated Notice Board M lettered "Commence propelling when White Light is Illuminated" will be provided as shown on attached diagram 355 yards from Ebbw Vale North G. F.

The Up Goods Starting Signal J will be repositioned as shown on attached diagram.

The Up Main to Goods Home signal D and the Ground disc Up Main to No. 2 Up Siding or No. 1 Up Siding C will be repositioned as shown on attached diagram 167 yards further from Ebbw Vale Sidings South G. F.

New Sidings and connections will be by might into use as about all diagram.

New Ground Frames controlled from Fbby Vale Sidings South G. F. and released by Key from Key Release Instruments will be provided to work connections marked X and Y on attached diagram and will be named as follows:-

Ebbw Vale West Ground Frame - Working Spring point X
Ebbw Vale East Ground Frame - Working Spring point Y
The existing Ebbw Vale North Ground Frame will work new
connections Z on attached diagram.

Telephones will be provided as shown or attached diagram.

During the occupation the Distant signal affected viz. UM18 will be maintained at Caution.

District Inspector, Newport, to make all arrangements including the provision of Hand Signalmen in accordance with Rule 77.
