The layout of the R. & S.B. Junction will be remodelled as shown in heavy type on the accompanying diagram. Track circuits will be re-arranged accordingly. All new connections will be operated by point machines of the electro hydraulic clamp lock type and instructions for the emergency operation of this type of point machine have been issued separately. Signal number PT499 will be re-positioned approximately 250 yards nearer to Jersey South with no alteration in form. Its associated AWS inductor will also be re-positioned approximately 250 yards nearer to Jersey South.

A new "limit of shunt" lamp will be provided as shown.


