Between Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 February, 1977.

In connection with the future relaying of the junction temporary alterations will be made as listed below and shown on the diagram overleaf.

The Up Main to Up Loop facing connection, the switch diamond and slip connection in the Down Main (taken out of use 1.2.77) will be relaid as plain line and the Up Loop will be taken out of use temporarily.

The following signals will be temporarily out of use:-

Up Main to Up Loop Home. Up Loop Starting. Ground Signal reading from Up Loop to Up Main.

The following signals will be recovered:-

Ground signal reading from Up Loop to Down Main. Ground signal reading from Down Main to Up Loop.

Track circuits will be rearranged accordingly.

Between Saturday 19 and Wednesday 23 March, 1977.

The junction will be relaid in the form shown on the diagram.

The Up Loop will be brought back into use. The following signals will be brought back into use:-

Up Main to Up Loop Home Up Loop Starting Ground Signal reading from Up Loop to Up Main.

Track circuits will be rearranged accordingly.
