NOTICE TO TRAINMEN ETC.SIGNAL ALTERATIONSOLD OAK COMMON - SOUTHALL EASTSATURDAY 5 MARCH TO MONDAY 7 MARCH 1977

Between 22.00 hours on Saturday 5 March and 06.00 hours on Monday 7 March 1977, or until completion, the Divisional Signal and Telecommunications Engineer will be engaged in carrying out the following work:-

Signals Nos. 0013, 0017 and 00217 will be taken out of use together with their associated A.W.S. inductors.

Signal No. 0015 altered as shown will be repositioned 200 yds. towards Reading in rear of its present position on the UP MAIN LINE. The associated A.W.S. inductor will be repositioned correspondingly.

NEW ROUTING OF SIGNAL NO. 0015

TO UP GOODS LOOP (219) MAIN SIGNAL OR DRAW AHEAD SIGNAL WITH JUNCTION INDICATOR POSITION 2.

TO UP RELIEF (119) MAIN SIGNAL WITH JUNCTION INDICATOR POSITION 1.

TO DOWN RELIEF (473) DRAW AHEAD SIGNAL

TO UP MAIN (UM8) MAIN SIGNAL

A new Ground Position Light Signal No. 00473 will be provided on the Up Side of the Down Relief at points 843B. This signal will be routed to the Up Goods Loop (00219) and the Up Relief (00119).

Signals No. 0011 and 00111 to Up Main will in future read to Signal No. 0015.

Ground Position Light Signals 00477, 00479 and 00481 previously reading to 00217 and 0017 will in future read to 00473 and UM8. Ground Position Light Signal 00483 previously reading to 00217 will in future read to 00473.

Track circuits will be adjusted accordingly.

Occupation of the signalling panel will be required for the purpose of testing.

During the occupation, signals 009, 11, 15, 115, 117, 46, 48, 146 and 148 will be disconnected and maintained at danger.

All arrangements for the safe working of the line, together with the appointment of any Handsignalmen required in accordance with Section E of the Rule Book will be made by the District Operating Inspector.
