WANTAGE ROAD-UFFINGTON

SATURDAY 31 JANUARY - MONDAY 2 FEBRUARY 1981

Between 22.15 on Saturday 31 January and 06.40 on Monday 2 February 1981 signals associated with reversible signalling over the Up Main will be commissioned and made available for use as follows :-

Routes to 'Down the Up Main' from signals R88 and R788

Between 22.15 on Saturday 7 February and 06.40 on Monday 9 February 1981 points, signals and A.W.S. inductors associated with reversible signalling over the Down Main will be commissioned and made available for use as follows :-

Routes to 'Up the Down Main' from signals SN91, SN93 and SN693.

Signals R703 and R703R together with their associated A.W.S. inductors.

The facing crossover at Uffington shown in heavy type on the diagram will be brought into use.

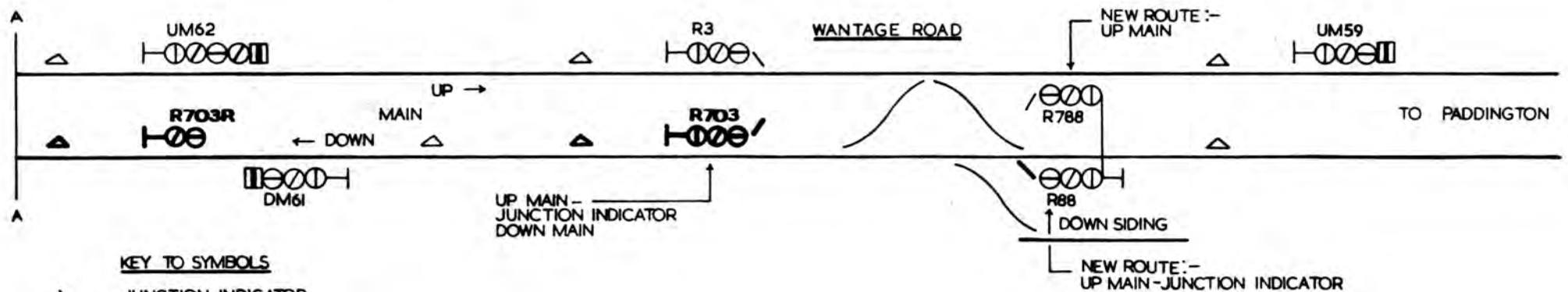
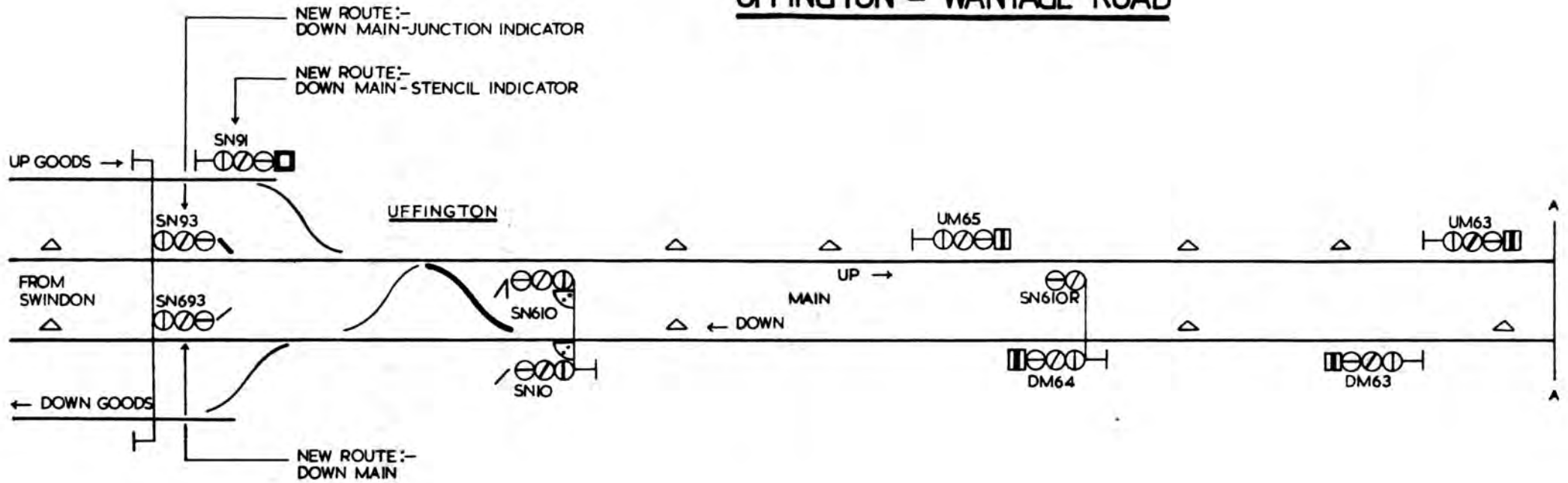
