SUPPLEMENTARY NOTICE OF SIGNALLING ALTERATIONS ETC.

SECTION 'C' OF THE K2/- SPEED AND ENGINEERING NOTICE

SWINDON PANEL

WOOTTON BASSETT WEST-HALLAVINGTON

BETWEEN SATURDAY 11 JULY AND MONDAY 13 JULY 1981

ALSO BETWEEN SATURDAY 18 JULY AND MONDAY 20 JULY 1981

Between 22.40 on Saturday 11 July and 06.40 on Monday 13 July, 1981, signals associated with reversible signalling over the Up Badminton line will be commissioned and made available for use as follows :-

Routes to 'Down the Up Badminton' from signal SN.164 and SN.764.

New signals SND.4 and SND.4R together with their associated A.W.S. inductors shown in heavy type on the diagram overleaf will be brought into use.

Between 22.40 on Saturday 18 July and 06.40 on Monday 20 July 1981, signals and points associated with reversible signalling over the Down Badminton line will be commissioned and made available for use as follows :-

New signals SNU.3 and SNU.3R together with their associated A.W.S. inductors shown in heavy type on the diagram will be brought into use.

Routes to 'Up the Down Badminton' from signal SN.133 and SN.733 together with the facing crossover at Hallavington shown in heavy type on the diagram will be brought into use.

A copy of this Notice will be issued to all trainmen on the section of line.

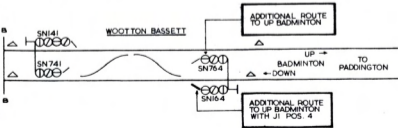
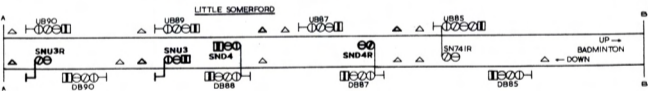
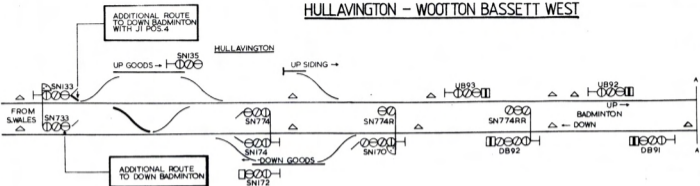
