The Down Main Distant Signal for Box will be moved 313 yards further from the signal box on the same side of the line, no alteration in height and the A.T.C. ramp for that signal will be taken up and refixed 440 yards in rear of the new position.

While the work is being carried out, the distant signals for Box and Farleigh Down affected will be disconnected and kept at caution.
